What is the Aurora Youth Team Tournament?

Want to earn points and win prizes with your friends, or make new friends through showing and riding? The Regional Youth Team Tournament allows teams to earn points from both recognized and non-recognized shows, leading up to year-end awards that are given to the highest scoring teams in each region. Regional winners will also be posted on the AHA youth webpage, and *Modern Arabian Horse* magazine. The teams are made up of 5-6 horse/rider combinations, and youth may be placed on more than one team. The cost of entering is **free** when you hold a current AHA competition card that is affiliated with Aurora Club, because Aurora will cover the entry cost for youth within their club.

What are the requirements?

- Youth must hold a current AHA competition card and be affiliated with Aurora
 - Can be purchased through the Arabian Horse Association (AHA) for \$25

 - Select [Aurora] as your club affiliation \$15
- Youth must be competing with an Arabian/Half-Arabian/Anglo-Arabian
 - you do NOT need to own the horse to be eligible
- You may enter with more than one horse
 - Only one horse/rider combination per team
- Youth may enter in both the Recognized and Non-Recognized divisions with the same horse or different horses
- Youth are required, but not limited to, compete in one show (in Region 17) in the show year.

Recognized vs Non-Recognized

Recognized

- Any AHA recognized shows within Region 17 will count, but NOT National Championships

Non Recognized

- Any show not recognized by AHA within Region 17 (schooling shows, endurance rides)
