Select	Has not received at least one of the following: 1. Has more than 100 AHA Achievement Points (150 for Youth) 2. Leveled out of the National Select Level	Has not received more than 20 AHA National Achievement Points
Choice	Has not received at least one of the following: 1. Has more than 250 AHA Achievement Points (300 for Youth) 2. Leveled out of the National Choice Select Level	Has received 30 AHA National Achievement Points but not more than 60 AHA National Achievement Points
Elite	Has received more than 250 AHA Achievement Points (300 for Youth)	Has received at least 70 AHA National Achievement Points
Primetime	AHA Member, USEF Amateur 60 Years of Age or Older	AHA Member, USEF Amateur 60 Years of Age or Older

- AHA Achievement Points earned by a Youth/Adult Amateur exhibitor do not count for the Open division.
